


| | Wine/Vintage | Points | Description |

|  | Barbaresco Gallina 2001 | 92 | The 2001 Barbaresco Gallina, with a very expansive nose of roses, damp earth, truffles, and wild fennel, is unusually firm and muscular for a wine from this vineyard, long and with a rising sense of power and authority on the finish. Drink: 2005-2016. |
|  | Barbaresco Staderi 2001 | 94 | The 2001 Barbaresco Staderi, from a vineyard in Neive, is, as always, the most powerful of the group, very penetrating on the nose with aromas of tar, licorice, chocolate, and truffles, potent and intense in flavor but very textured and caressing as well, a wine of truly superior balance and class which will still be drinking well between 2018 and 2020. |
|  | Barbaresco Valeirano 2001 | 93 | The 2001 Barbaresco Valeirano offers much raspberry and black cherry fruit in its aromatic range, together with notes of smoke and minerals. More concentrated than the Barbaresco Gallina on the palate, it is also suppler and more velvety, quite warm and broad on the finish. Drink: 2005-2017. |
|  | Barolo Campé 2000 | 94 | The 2000 Barolo Campe, the first which Rivetti has made, is very fresh and vigorous for a wine from this hot vintage, spicy and balsamic in aroma with much tar and chocolate as well, dense flavors, much length and intensity, and a sizeable but supple close. Already quite approachable, it will last another decade and a half. |
